In fact, research has shown that effective leaders have a strong set of emotional skills in common that manifests in a variety of leadership "styles." This is where a leader becomes more than a manager. And where a nonprofit evolves from an organization doing good to an organization doing great.

High performing nonprofits think about their organizations as much more than the boxes and lines on an "org chart." Bridgespan finds that truly effective organizations exhibit strengths in five key interrelated areas: leadership, decision-making and structure, people, work processes and systems, and culture (see Exhibit 1).

How can nonprofit organizations become more effective? In our experience, and in line with organizational research from Bain & Company, Inc., to be fully effective an organization must demonstrate strength in each of the following areas: leadership, decision making and structure, people, work processes and systems, and culture.
