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Malcolm X wrote this to show that even at your lowest points, you still have the same values as when you are at your highest. Malcolm X showed readers that he was able to learn how to read write in prison to convey his support for Elijah Muhammed and the Muslim religion. If he was able to do this, so can any other normal person.

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In his Autobiography, Malcolm emphasizes multiple times the important role books have played in his life and in developing his thinking. For example, he invested much of his energy into learning history through books such as *The Souls of Black Folk* by W. E. B. Du Bois, or H. G.

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
