
We will have treats, gift making stations, and a very special Grinchy guest! More info coming soon on the Toy Drive that accompanies this annual event We hope you save the date for this special day!

Health Bulletin:

Cold and flu season is upon us! We are making every effort to keep Puzzle's clean through daily cleanings, health checks, and lots of handwashing! Please join us in our efforts by taking the following steps:

- Wash/sanitize your hands as you enter the building. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the center for your convenience.
- If you enter an infant or toddler/crawlers classroom, please remember to remove your shoes or to put on the provided shoe covers.
- We have relocated cubbies back into the classroom to help keep our hallways clear. They are conveniently located just inside the doorway of each room so that we can limit the spread of germs throughout our play space.
- Children will be sent home with fevers of 100.1 or higher, vomiting, diarrhea, etc. Please keep your child home until they have been symptom-free without the aid of medication for at least 24 hours. See our full illness policy for more information.
